French

- We are working on saying "J'aime" (I Like), "je n'aime pas" (I don't like) with the help of our practice foods
- Working on saying "Je voudrais... s'il vous plait" (I would like... please)

ELA

- Introducing the letter F, tracing uppercase and lowercase F
- Tracing words beginning with F
- Using our soundbox

Math

- Finishing our number books
- Introducing addition by using manipulatives
- Presentation using a number puzzle which had a number on one side and the same number of dots on the other. These pieces fit together like a puzzle, allowing the children to check their work
- In addition to the puzzle, we used counters to show the number represented on the puzzle

Practical Life

- All the activities are helping work the children's small motor skills: pouring, tracing, sorting, folding, lacing

Books
