- Fluency within 5 and 10

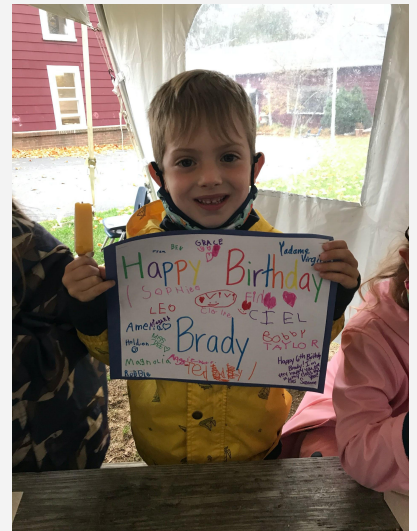
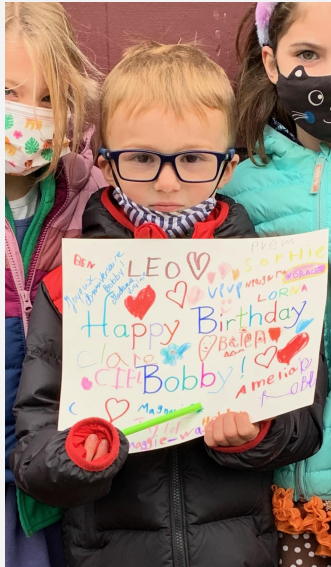
ELA
