The children were given the following lessons.

Whole Group Second and Third Grade

- Health: Wrote & performed skits on how to be kind to others in multiple school/home scenarios
- Writing: Began final drafts of thankful letters
- Field Trip: Visited the House of the Seven Gables along with first grade. We drove in the school vans, and learned about daily living in seventeenth century Massachusetts. The children took a tour of the house, carded wool, and played with authentic toys from the era.
- History: Discussed what is the House of 7 Gables and the people who lived there and compared how our clothes in 2022 are similar and different than clothes from the 1600s

2nd Grade

- Math- Completed Module 3 assessment and began Module 4 on addition and subtraction strategies 1-200, or created stores (learning about products, cost, marketing, & business planning)
- Reading- Leveled reading groups
- Spelling- multi-syllable v-e words, suffix ive, trick words together, place, right
- Social Studies- Completed unit on Culture and Traditions and our country study of China. Began unit on maps, overviewing key concepts and the
