The children in the Maple Room were given the following lessons. Please ask your child about what they learned.

- **Biography Presentation:** Sheryl Faye presented a one-woman show on the life of Sally Ride, including interactive science experiments, followed by a Q&A
- **Cultural:** Sylvia Kane presented on her personal childhood experience as a Polish refugee. We made connections to the current crisis in Ukraine.
- **Writing:** Wrote friendly letters to send to children in refugee camps. We included jokes, pictures, and friendly messages to brighten their day.
- **Science:** Lessons on scientific observation and testable questions, the scientific method, identifying properties of matter, and an experiment on buoyancy
- **Language:** Learned to segment and spell 2-syllable words, including compound words. Trick words were People and Month
- **Math:** Learned to tell time up to the half-hour, and counting by 5s around the clock.
- **Math:** Completed Module 5 assessment on geometry and analog clocks
- **Art:** Learned how to make a spiral, accordion, and teardrop shape with paper strips, and worked with the challenge of making a 3-D structure with 2-D materials.
- **Reading:** Leveled groups reading this week: Nate the Great, Judy Moody Gets Famous, and Days with Frog and Toad.
