- Holiday Party Day on the last day of school! We decorated the classroom with handmade snowflakes and paper chains, decorated gingerbread houses (Wednesday), watched Elf with Elm, and enjoyed hot chocolate and popcorn outside.
- Graders Community Service: Read Last Stop on Market Street and learned and discussed what the words “soup kitchen” and “homeless” mean. Made and packaged brownies, drew pictures, and made cards to deliver to My Brother’s Table in Lynn.
- Language: Trick words Why, by, my, try
- Language: Writing with glued sounds -ang, -ing, -ong, -ung

- Cultural: Made Stonehenge replicas out of clay
- Math: Solving multi-step word problems with missing addend.
- Math: Learned and used the RDW (Read, Draw, Write) strategy to independently solve word problems.
- Math: Making “true number sentences” by solving and matching equivalent expressions (ex. $14 - 7 = 3 + 4$)
