- We had a presentation on folding from Mimi. Students have started to fold our napkins and placemats in the morning so that we can use them at lunchtime.
- After the snowstorm, we practiced getting all of our outdoor gear on independently and in the right order
- We had a presentation on how to fill a dropper with water and place droplets into small wells
- We had a presentation on pouring water from one container into smaller ones, and then pouring the water back into the original container. Once the water was poured back, Mimi demonstrated how to clean up any spills with a sponge and how to wring it out.
